Take Home Instructions for Oct. 31 to Nov. 5th

Each student should complete the following task:

- 1. Write down the types of paper, plastics, glass, metals, and all other thrash thrown away in your home for 1 week.
 - a. Record the type of recyclable items found in trash onto Recycling Track Sheet (newspaper, magazine, coke bottle, milk jug)
 - b. Write the number of each recyclable item in its specific column.
- 2. Answer the five recycling questions about your our findings
- 3. Bring the completed Questions and Daily Recycling Track Sheet to class on November 6.
- 4. Save and bring to class one recyclable cardboard toilet tissue roll on November 6.
